



Project reference: Victoria Bridge, Bath

Balfour Beatty approached Centregreat to form part of their bid submission team for the project to reinstate the listed Victoria Bridge Structure in Bath back to its former glory.

The existing bridge was supported by a Mabey system which the Client was looking to remove. We were involved in detailed discussions with Balfour Beatty and the client prior to contract award to discuss methods on approach and execution of project, with some of the operations being complex. These meetings gave the client confidence in the ability of the team to manage and deliver the project within their budget and timeframe.

The project itself included dismantling the existing structure and delivering sections to our Cardiff workshops where individual components were given identification marks for reference. The intention was to retain as much of the existing structure as possible, however a new deck and replacement parts of the supporting structure were required. The existing structure components were blasted back to bare metal to remove traces of lead paint and the complete structure painted to the client's specification. This project was a success and, as shown in the photographs, was officially opened by the Mayor.
